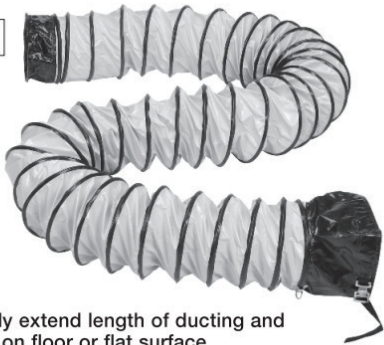

Untie string to unfold ducting.

Fully extend length of ducting and lay on floor or flat surface.

3



Open & unfurl the quick-connect end of ducting.
Note: Quick-connect end includes strap and buckle.

Wrap the quick-connect end over the edging of blower fan.
Note: Wrap ducting over air outlet for ventilation or over the air inlet for exhausting applications.

5



Pull the strap and adjust the buckle over the duct edging to secure duct in place.
