



TIPS and HINTS:

1. Find the ON button and press it. If the GREEN colour is shown, that means the battery is ready for action. If no light is on, that means it is out of juice. Charge it first before using it.
2. You shall see the battery connector at the back of the headlight. Slide the battery into the socket, and you are ready for action! You can put on another battery should you want to get longer working hours out of your Grizzlylight.
3. Make sure you put the protective cap back on after you have charged your battery. If not, the battery won't be protected from the dust and water. Should you break the cap, you need to know that your battery won't be IP65 anymore, and the warranty will be voided from thereon. Therefore, make sure you take good care of your Grizzlylight as if it's a member of your family!
4. Make sure you charge your Grizzly battery pack every three months if you don't use it to prolong its life.
5. Another tip to prolong the life of Lithium Ion battery pack is to NOT charge it at 100% constantly but three quarter of that would do.
6. Don't try to be an Einstein. If you find your Grizzlylight not working, bring it back to your dealer and they will sort it out for you. Warranty is there for a reason. The moment you attempt to tamper with Grizzlylight, the warranty will be voided.
7. Take good care of your chargers. Should you lose it, you will have to buy yourself a replacement.

1 year LIMITED warranty:

Grizzly Enterprises Limited warrants this product against defects in materials and/or workmanship under normal use for a period of ONE (1) YEAR from the date of purchase by the original purchaser (Warranty Period). If a defect arises and a valid claim is received within the Warranty Period, at its option, Grizzly will either 1) repair the defect at no charge, using new or refurbished replacement parts, or 2) replace the product with a new product that is at least functionally equivalent to the original product, or 3) provide a store credit in the amount of the purchase price of the original product. A replacement product or part, including a user-installable part installed in accordance with instructions provided by Grizzly Enterprises Limited assumes the remaining warranty of the original product. When a store credit is given, the original product MUST BE returned to Grizzly Enterprises Limited and become our property.

Obtaining service: To obtain warranty service, please email us on info@grizzlylight.co.nz. Please be prepared to describe the product that needs service and the nature of the problem. A purchase receipt is required. All repairs and replacements must be authorised in advance. Service options, parts availability and response times will vary. You are responsible for delivery and the cost of delivery of the product or any parts to the authorised service centre for replacement, per our instructions.

Limits and Exclusions: Coverage under this Limited Warranty is limited to Australia and New Zealand. This Limited Warranty applies only to products manufactured for Grizzly Enterprises Limited that can be identified by the "Grizzlylight" trademark, trade name, or logo affixed to them or their packaging. The Limited Warranty does not apply to any non-Grizzly Enterprises Limited products. Manufacturers or suppliers other than Grizzly Enterprises Limited may provide their own warranties to the Purchaser, but we in so far as permitted by law, provides these products "as is".
